Kids Cancer Care is a local charity which truly makes a difference in the lives of children suffering with cancer. They have programs which are uniquely designed to meet the needs of entire families at each stage of the cancer journey, from diagnosis through treatment and beyond. One hundred percent of pledges that are collected by our "shavees" will go to providing funding and programs in three areas: camp, research, and education programs.

Our event will take place on **May 31, 2018** (time TBD) and will be a community event featuring music, speeches, education on Kids Cancer Care, as well as the shave! Teacher and student volunteers will be shaving their heads or cutting their hair in order to raise funds as well as to stand in solidarity with childhood cancer patients to show that "Bald is Beautiful!"

We are beginning to seek pledges to support those students and teachers brave enough to take on this challenge.
